The Cost vs. Value 2014 study has been released by Remodeling Magazine. This is an important study for anyone planning a remodeling project. The study measures the resale value of a remodeling project against the cost of the project. The cost numbers are adjusted geographically and percentages are assigned for resale value.



At R. Craig Lord Construction we love this study and while it was a lot of fun in 2008 to tell Mrs. Jones that her kitchen would be worth 106% of what we charged her we still think that even at today's numbers the study shows that remodeling your house is still one of the best investments a homeowner can do.

Here are some of the resale value percentages for remodeling jobs in our area.

- Major Kitchen Remodel 63.8%
- Attic Bedroom 75.8%
- Two Story Addition 60.2%
- Upscale Bathroom Remodel 52.7%
- Basement Remodel 60.5 %

The highest return on a project goes to Entry Door Replacement where in our region you would spend on the average \$1,177 which would be worth \$1,098 in resale value for a percentage of 93.4%.

On the whole the cost-value ratio for 2014 is 66.1% its' highest value since 2008. This reflects the rising resale value of homes. As pointed out many times before on these pages the added benefit of a remodeling project is the use and enjoyment you get from a new room or feature. Remember you take a long hot bath in your new tub or you could take a bath in the stock market. Which is more enjoyable?


